REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- 1) Use the registration form on the next page. Only one child per form. Additional Forms are available at the Island Lake Village Hall and on the website www.villageofislandlakd.com in the Current Recreation Guide.
- 2) Creative Playtime requires a **non-refundable** yearly registration fee of \$40/child at the time of registration. Checks should be made payable to the Village of Island Lake.
- 3) Bring the registration form, state registered birth certificate and registration fee to the Creative Playtime Office at the Village Hall, 3720 Greenleaf Avenue, Island Lake.
- 4) No tuition refund after current session has begun. Refunds are subject to administrative approval and will require a \$20 handling fee.
- 5) We reserve the right to consolidate, change time or cancel a class due to registration.

2 - YEAR OLD

For children born between Sept. 2, 2006 and Sept. 1, 2007.

Class time is one hour of activities which emphasize goals that are specifically geared to the attention span of the 2 year old. Since this class is designed to be without parents, separation needs to be accomplished prior to the start of class in the fall..

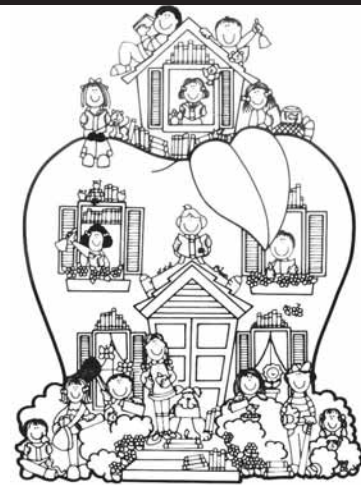

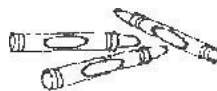
"I agree to waive and relinquish all claims my child/ward may have as a result of participating in the program against the Village of Island Lake and its officers, agents, servants, and employees."
